

INSTRUCTIONS

Here are some instructions for our new line of green dyes for mosses:

- it cannot be used on its own: it needs to be diluted in water. However, we recommend diluting it into a mix of water and glycerin (which we can also supply).

- use a spray bottle to apply it to the moss; make sure to spread it evenly.

- start with a low dilution and add your water and glycerin mix until you achieve the desired colour.

!! the more you dilute, the lighter the color of the dye will become !!

- we highly recommend testing your dilution on a piece of moss before applying it to the wall.

- the same dilution will not always provide the same color on various moss species as they will absorb it differently.

- the total area of coverage will be directly related to how much spray is added to the wall (500 ml of water + 500 ml of glycerin should be enough for 50 sqft of wall space).

200 ml of dye
800 ml of water
